## 2. Transportation to and from “Casa Agnethe”

### **Local Bus to Malaga and Marbella**

Next to the gas station, 5-minute walk towards Fuengirola the bus will go to Marbella/Fuengirola, depending on which side of the road you are on. Going to “Casa Agnethe” you can take the “220” Fuengirola-Marbella bus. Per 11.7.21 it leaves every 30 min, from Fuengirola bus stop.

### **Airport bus**

Airport bus is available twice a day from the reception 70 meters from the house. Please check times at the reception.

### **By taxi**

Taxi is available at the reception 70 meters from the house.

### **By train**

Train is available to and from the Airport to Fuengirola, you can grab a taxi for 5-10 Euros from Fuengirola to the house.

## 3. House Manual

We hope you will enjoy your stay in Casa Agnethe at Wyndham La Costa resort!

To help you achieve a great vacation we advise you to read this guide and to make use of the resort’s facilities. We can also recommend visiting the webpage for the house at [www.casaagnethe.eu](http://www.casaagnethe.eu) for more information and guides for activities and places to see. Please see the instructions below on how to operate the appliances within the home.


### **Air Conditioning / Heating**

Air conditioning is provided in the living room and all bedrooms. One remote per AC. There is a wall mounted push button system turning the AC off after 4 hours of use. After that the air conditioning stops and you need to push the button at the wall again to make it start. This is to preserve electricity and prevent damage to the AC. When you leave the house, please turn off the air conditioning. Please do not use the AC while the doors are open. If remote controls are broken, please let the houseowner know, replacements will be charged at 50€.

### **Tv**

This house has a 65” Samsung Smart TV with streaming channels. If you want other channels you will have to use your computer or tablet to go through the internet. The TV has several media streaming possibilities like Netflix and Chromecast.

### **Chromecast**

Chromecast is supplied with the tv in the living room and accessible through the WiFi. The Chromecast can be used for streaming video, and photos from computers, cell phones or other media. On your phone or computer find this “Cast button”  to use Chromecast.

**WiFi**

There is free Wifi in the house.

**Keys**

All tenants get 2 pair of keys. Make sure you don't leave them behind. There are locks on every gate, therefore you need the keys to enter the separate gates. Never remove the key from the door to the terrace by the pool. Make sure you lock all the windows, the gate to the terrace and the front door. Never leave the front door unlocked while you are on the backside of the house. The door to the terrace is locked by lifting the door handle and turning the key.

**Barbecue**

IMPORTANT: Distance the BBQ from the wall, roof and awning before use. If not, it will leave burn marks. Gas containers are in the small "house" on the terrace.

**Parking Space**

This property has a private parking space in front of the house. Pay attention to the green gate in the front of the house. Make sure it is closed so it does not cause damage to the cars passing by. Other parking spaces in the area is marked. To "lock" it, pull the gate with some force until it "clicks". Don't smash the gate closed.

**Garbage**

The garbage is collected every evening at the collection point (the garbage containers are in front of the house to the left). Grey containers are for "everything". Yellow and green are for recycling. Please make sure you don't leave any food uncovered. Leftovers will attract ants, flies, and rodents to the area.

**Ant/Insect spray**

This is provided in the cabinet in the kitchen.



## 3.1 Rules for the house

### Pets

Pets are not allowed in this house. Please don't feed any cats as they will return after you leave and be an annoyance for the next tenant. If you see abandoned animals, you can let the reception know.

### Parties

It is not allowed to have parties at the house or in the resort. Quiet times is after 10pm (22:00). In case of complaints from the neighbors about too much noise or bad behavior, guests can be evicted, this would not qualify for any repayment.

### Smoking

**Smoking is not allowed inside the house.** You can smoke outside at the terrace. Make sure that you drop your cigarettes in the ash tray. It's forbidden to throw away burning cigarettes, there are high fines for this. If smoking inside, we need to steam all furniture, curtains, and the house. A minimum of 400€ will be charged if smoking inside is detected.

### IN CASE OF FIRE

Use the Fire extinguisher immediately! It is placed in the closet in the hall.

In case of oil, grease or butter burning, use the fire blanket. This is in the closet next to the refrigerator.

First Aid Kit is placed in the closet next to the refrigerator.

Call 112 immediately! Explain them there is a FUEGO, give them the address of the house, and say it is in Wyndham Costa Resort.

### Information about your last day

Checkout is at the latest 10:00 in the morning, unless otherwise agreed. The cleaning personnel are coming to clean for the next tenants. If you need assistance with the last day facilities, please ask us. We will help if we can. Late checkout might be possible if there are no other guests arriving at the same day.



## 4. Community Rules

The community rules are set by the Resort Community. The community has a strict policy on the rules, so please pay attention to them. It is mandatory for the homeowner to let the guest know about these rules.

### **Pools**

The swimming pools are open from sunrise to sunset. The pool is not to be used outside these times or when it is being cleaned.

NO dogs are allowed in or around the swimming pools for hygiene reasons.

NO radios, Walkman's, disc players, mp3 players, etc. (except with headphones) are allowed.

NO glass or crockery are to be used in the pool or garden areas of the community.

NO inflatables or ball games are allowed.

It is obligatory to shower before entering the pool. It is forbidden to enter the bathing area wearing street clothes or shoes. It is forbidden to eat or smoke inside the pool. All litter must be disposed of in the litterbins provided. Please do not leave any food or drink lying around in communal areas to avoid vermin, ants, rats and mice. Babies must wear nappies in the pool. They should not enter adult pools. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult and wear buoyancy aids unless they are competent swimmers. The children pools are for the use of children under 6 years of age. It is strictly forbidden to reserve any of the community sun beds. All towels or objects used in this manner will be removed.

### **Community Toilets**

NO plastic, nappies, sanitary towels, etc. are to be disposed of in the toilets as these items may block the pipes. Please dispose of these in the bins provided. The toilets are cleaned daily. Please help to keep these areas in a clean and tidy condition for other owners and guests.

### **Noise**

No noise is allowed to disturb the neighbors or the tranquility of the area. NO noise in summer after 24.00 hours and 23.00 hours during the remainder of the year. These are Town Hall regulations. Please also respect siesta hours: from 14.00 to 16.30 hours.

### **No hanging out of clothes**

It is forbidden to hang washing out in public view. This includes hanging towels over balcony railings or walls. Owners should use the clothes horses provided to dry their washing. It is also forbidden to dry clothes at the windows.

### **Cars and Motor Vehicles**

The Municipal rules prohibit the washing of cars on the roads. NO oil changing. Oil is highly contaminating and is therefore totally forbidden. NO parking on roads, kerbs or paths is allowed. Please leave your car in a parking space. Park between the lines where marked.

### **Barbecues**

Only gas barbecues are permitted in Marina del Sol Fase 1&2. The use of charcoal barbecues together with barbecue fluid which is extremely inflammable is prohibited

### **Rubbish & Rubbish Areas – “Basura”**

Recycling of waste is essential for our planet. Please dispose of your waste correctly.

GREY Containers: - Kitchen rubbish (organic waste) should be placed in a sealed garbage bag and disposed of in the dark grey containers. YELLOW Containers: - Plastics, tetra-bricks and tins should be disposed of in the yellow containers.

BLUE Containers: - Paper and cardboard should be disposed of in the blue containers. Any empty cardboard boxes should be folded flat prior to disposal. GREEN Containers: - Glass and glass bottles should be disposed of in the green containers.

### **Security**

Please close all gates, doors and garage entrances and exits to maintain the area secure. Security affects us all.

### **Water**

Water is a scarce commodity. Please be economical with it. Do not allow your children to play with the swimming pool showers or garden hoses.

## 5. Location of Local Services

### **Bus to Malaga & Marbella**

Next to the gas station, 5-minute walk towards Fuengirola the bus will go to Marbella/Fuengirola, depending on which side of the road you are on.

### **Pharmacy & Doctor**

The nearest pharmacy is in Fuengirola.

In case you need a doctor, there is one at the resort 50m from the house, on the left side. You can see the opening hours at the door. In case of an emergency, you can call 112. Be aware you have your social security card, or your insurance card with you. You will need it to see a doctor, or if you need to go to the hospital. The ambulance will always bring you to the nearest state hospital. But when you have travel or private health insurance, you need to tell them this.

### **Police**

The nearest Police Station is in Fuengirola. They can be reached on the number marked in the beginning of the Guide, or at 112.

### **Supermarket**

There is a small store at the resort, just 70m from the house, on the left side next to the reception. The store supplies fresh bread and other necessities. If you walk further there is another small shop that sells fruit and such. This is located when you walk past all year heated pool on the right side. In Fuengirola there is a Lidl, a Mercadona and a Carrefour inside the Miramar Shopping Mall. Miramar is located about 15 minutes' walk towards Fuengirola. During summer a lot of supermarkets is open on also on Sundays.

### **Shopping**

There are some huge shopping malls at the Costa del Sol. In Torremolinos you have the Plaza Mayor, with lots of shops, stores, and restaurants. Only 15 minutes by foot you have the Miramar Shopping Mall and the biggest of them all is La Cañada in Marbella. It is also very nice to go to Malaga, to the historic center, with lots of shops, gift shops, nice bars, and restaurants.








On the Highway N340, you have petrol stations in both directions. There is a petrol station 300m before the entrance of the resort, direction Fuengirola.

### **Bank or Atm – Money Exchange**

There are a few bank machines in the Resort. The closest is located across the reception. Many banks have an office in Fuengirola and La Cala.

## 6. What to do at the Resort

The Wyndham Costa resort has a lot to offer. For instance:

<p><b>The Wyndham train</b></p> <p>The train will take you around the resort for <u>free</u> and it operates daily from 9am – 11.30pm. It runs every ½ hour. One complete journey takes approximately 15 minutes although times do vary. The train does make some noise.</p>	
<p><b>Shop/Bakery</b></p> <p>The local shop/bakery is located about 50 meters from the house, in the round-about. There is another shop if you walk passed the whole year heated pool on the right.</p>	
<p><b>Restaurants</b></p> <p>There are several restaurants at the resort. The closest is located by the round-about and is called Zacharys.</p>	
<p><b>Gym</b></p> <p>There is a gym located on the other side of the resort. Refer to the map for description.</p>	
<p><b>Children's club</b></p> <p>Children's club is available at the resort. Consult the reception for more information.</p>	
<p><b>Transportation</b></p> <p>There is a bus stop by the reception area that will take you to Malaga airport. There are also taxis available here. Check the reception for times for the bus.</p>	
<p><b>Spa</b></p> <p>These are also spa treatments and hair Salon in the complex. Consult the reception for more information.</p>	
<p><b>Bike Hire</b></p> <p>From the Reception you can rent bikes, scooter and baby buggies</p>	



## 7. Things to do and see in Costa del Sol

### Bars and Restaurant

The resort provides several restaurants and bars. Fuengirola, as well as La Cala de Mijas, have many nice restaurants with all kinds of different food. Check out [www.tripadvisor.com](http://www.tripadvisor.com) for recommendations.

### Local Markets

#### *La Cala de Mijas and Fuengirola*

The largest Market is held on **Wednesdays** and **Saturdays** at La Cala where they sell fruit, vegetables, clothes, souvenirs, and flowers. You can either take the bus to La Cala or by car you need to take exit La Cala on the A7. The market is visible from the motorway.

### Fuengirola

On **Tuesday** morning you can go to Fuengirola for shopping in the local markets. These markets are located on the parking lot of Los Boliches, near the river. Here is also live music. During the high season it can be very crowded, and parking can be difficult.

### Saturday

The Secondhand Market in Fuengirola is a traditional shopping event. The city's fair grounds host this market on Saturday, and it draws locals and tourists alike to explore the fascinating collections of goods for sale. Some of the more unusual items for sale include army helmets, mannequins, and license plates.



The market generally runs from 0900 to 1400.

### Water Park (Aquamijas)

Also known as Aquamijas, has five water slides - three for older children and two for younger children. Very nice waterpark and not too big. You can also play mini golf, climb on the climbing wall, or relax in a jacuzzi.

### **Parasailing Fuengirola**

Fuengirola offers several opportunities for Parasailing. The flight lasts about 10 minutes and up to 6 people can “fly” together.

### **Costa Water Park**

Costa Water Park is an inflatable, floating obstacle course located on the shorelines of both Mijas and Fuengirola from the 1<sup>st</sup> of July each year. The playground is located about 70 meters from the shoreline and floats above relatively deep water.

### **Bioparc Fuengirola (Zoo)**

### **Rio Chillar**

Rio Chillar offers a fantastic hike in the upstream river from Neerja and into the mountains. You may walk for up to 10 km, but by walking 5km you will experience a wonderful river, with swimming possibilities and waterfalls. This is a must see if you can drive to Neerja where the trip starts. Neerja is located about 1 hours' drive from the house, past Malaga. We suggest that you use Google Maps for directions, it will take you to the start.

### **Butterfly Park (Mariposario de Benalmadena)**

In this spectacular Butterfly Park, next to the Thai temple, you can walk amongst more than 1,500 exotic butterflies from around the world, flying freely in a tropical paradise between waterfalls and flowers. You will be able to observe how they are born, how they reproduce and enjoy learning many things about these wonderful insects. There are also turtles, birds, fish, a wallaby, and a large Iguana in the butterfly park. Located in Benalmadena, 25 minutes from the house towards Malaga.

## 8. Festivities in and around Fuengirola

These are some of the festivities you can go to in Spain during the year. If interested, please double check the dates, some of them might have changed.

### April and May

#### *International Fair of the People*

Takes place from Tuesday 30th of April to Sunday 5th of May. More than 30 countries will show their culture, gastronomy, crafts, and their folklore. A great multicultural event that attracted a million visitors last year. It takes place at the feria place in Fuengirola (same place as the Saturday Market.)



### Sardines in La Cala

Takes place on May 1. On this day many people go to La Cala to enjoy some grilled sardines on the beach. Thanks to the cooperation of local restaurants are offered for free over 1000 kilos of roasted sardines to distribute to all attendees.



### June

#### *Night of San Juan – Fuengirola & Malaga*

On the night of June 23 to 24, a large part of the coastal population moves to the beaches at sunset accompanied by friends, family, food, and drink to celebrate the night of San Juan that ends with several bonfires on the beach. People will be dancing and bathing at midnight. Many of them enjoy this until the dawn of the warm night and the official start of summer.



#### *Floral offering to the Virgen de la Peña*

Virgen de la Peña is the patron saint of Mijas.

#### *Mijas International Blues Festival*

The Blues Festival is held in Mijas Pueblo during June.

### July

#### *Beer Festival*

During the month of July, the famous Beer Festival in honor of the Oktoberfest takes place in Fuengirola inside the Sohail Castle that is only 10-15 minutes' walk from the house. You get to taste typical dishes of Germany and, of course, beer! Previous editions were held at the beginning or end of August, so it is not held on an exact date.

### ***Virgen del Carmen***

In the afternoon of July 16th, the maritime procession of the Virgen del Carmen takes place, the patron saint of the sailors; a beautiful and emotional procession, where the Virgin is taken to the sea among thousands of flowers.

### ***The Fair of Las Lagunas***

Takes place in early July with variable dates commemorating the Virgen de la Paz. This fair begins with a colorful pilgrimage with oxcarts, carriages and horsemen. During the fair there is live music, contests and exhibitions, and attractions and booths at the fairgrounds.

### **August**

#### ***Medieval Market of Fuengirola***

During the month of August takes place, a trip in the time set up inside the Sohail castle walls, when all efforts are made to re-create the atmosphere of those historic times in this very appropriate setting. There are stalls with food and drink of the period. People are dressed in authentic mediaeval outfits and music and side shows go on from the morning and right into the night.

#### ***Vive Mijas de Noche***

During the months of July and August in Mijas Pueblo there is a program with craft markets, live music and other attractive events taking place during the nights of the summer months in the old part of town.

### **September**

#### ***Fair in Mijas Pueblo***

In honor of its patron saint, the Virgen de la Peña, with an extensive program of activities for all ages. The Tourist Day takes place around September 14th in the old town of Mijas Pueblo, with many activities to acknowledge the loyalty of the tourists who come each year to this Costa del Sol town.

### **October**

#### ***Feria de Fuengirola/ Feria del Rosario***

An important feria in Andalusia with the horse as protagonist and the fairgrounds are adorned with their best traditional costumes; the streets of the city are filled with carriages and a continuous atmosphere of celebration during the day and at night.

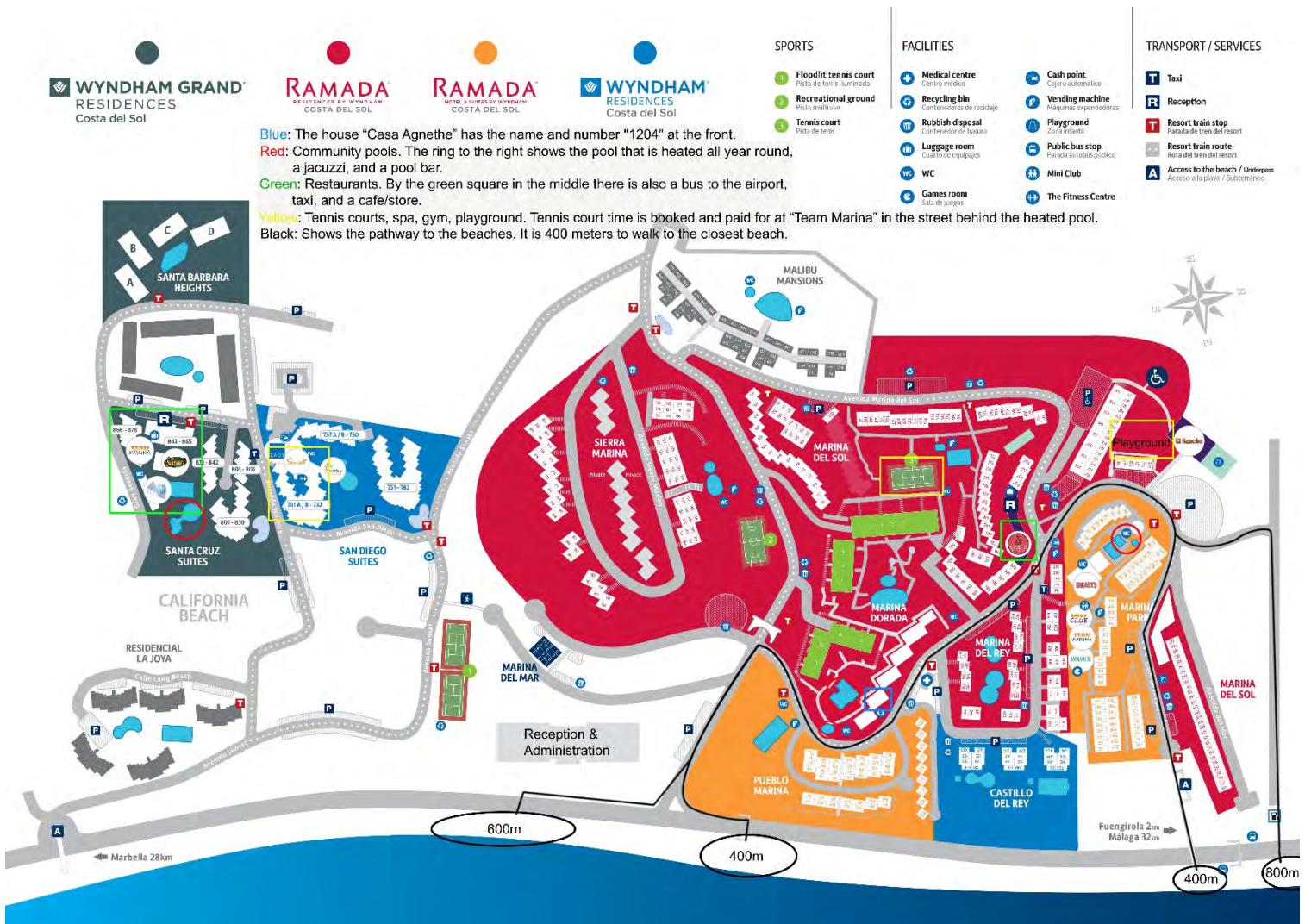
### **STARLITE FESTIVAL**

## 9. Map of area



**Blue:** This is “Casa Agnethe”. The house has the number "1204" and the name "Casa Agnethe" at the front.

**Red:** Community pools that you can use. The ring furthest to the right shows the pool that is heated all year round, a jacuzzi, and a pool bar.

**Green:** Restaurants. By the green square in the middle there is also a bus to the airport, taxi, and a cafe/store.

**Yellow:** Tennis courts, spa, gym, playground. Tennis court time is booked and paid for at “Team Marina” in the street behind the heated pool.

**Black lines:** Shows the pathway to the beaches. It is 400 meters to walk to the closest beach, while 600 and 800 meters to larger beaches.
